Home School – High School Learning Center

Fact Sheet

The High School Learning Center is a physical location where home schooled high school students can gather together to research projects, study together, receive mentoring and tutoring, learn important work skills, socialize and participate in the school's arts program all within our organic education environment. Community service internships and job placement opportunities will also be available.

We can assist parents in obtaining a church school cover and creating an appropriate course of study that meets your child's unique needs. We can provide high school level text books and reference materials. There will be a computer lab in the high school lab/lounge with wireless internet access and individual work space. High Schoolers are encouraged to provide their own laptop computer.

The Center will be open Monday – Thursday from 8:00 a.m. until 4 p.m. We will have an open attendance policy though students will be required to sign in when they arrive on campus and out when they leave. Families are free to choose the number of days per week the student will attend. This will determine fees and scheduling requirements.

Teachers will rotate in and out of the lab/lounge starting at 9:00 to assist students with special projects and provide individual tutorials.
